Medical issues

Children got suffered from viral eye flu and common cold, with monsoon comes there is risk of many diseases. The eye flu cases are reported each year during monsoon season. Symptoms could be redness and itching in eyes. Black goggles were provided to the children for not spreading the flu. Children were directed to use their personal things.

Repair and Maintenance

There was no maintenance work during the month, but the washing machine needs to install after constructing the suitable place to keep it. Washing machine and vacuum cleaner were bought during this month thanks to a donation by SSCHN.



Toyaj

Toyaj is reintegrated to a rented home near by Duhabi. After many discussions with Toyaj, Board members of DH and with the president of SSCHN it was finalized to find 1 room for him and provide needed things for 3 months. For the first 3-month support with SSCHN, DH will assist him with the needed things like house rent, food materials and medical expenses if needed. OM have filled his vacancy form in APF Armed Police Force for job.



Education

Exam results of children were distributed this month. Surya acquired 82%, Jitendra acquired 84%, Kailash acquired 78%, Bijay acquired 81%, Shristy with 77%, got failed in 3 subjects. According to her tuition teacher she is weak in social studies, science and Nepali. Besides, the results of other children had not published.

During the first week of month there were examination of Ritan, Balen, Karan, Karuna, Ram and Laxman.

Hygiene

Due to the increase in case of Dengue, a mosquito-borne disease in Dharan and most of the part of terai regions, Home mother, Kitchen mother and Asst. Staff were suggested to clean toilets, bathroom and surrounding regularly. OM sprayed insecticides in the surrounding and home premises.
