While discussing agenda number 3, it was decided that out of the 2 employees who were appointed for this foundation, Mr. Arjun K.C security guard did not perform satisfactory in the trial, so he will not resume his service and he will be dismissed with an addition of Rs 4000. Since Deepa was found to be good during the probationary period, it was decided to appoint her on contract and to provide remuneration as per the rules of the foundation.

The meeting concluded with the information that no decision had been made on miscellaneous matters.

Mr. Krishna Youngan Tamang, a member of Supervisory Committee regularly visited to DH and inspect the work of OM, Home mother, Kitchen mother and other staff members and also had meeting with the child club of home.

Toyaz won third prize in 4X400 relay race which was held on September 14 to September 17, conducted by state sports development state number 1, Nepal.

Children's are regularly taking their tuition class with their hired teachers. There are two different teachers hired for different level of student, in the morning time children up to class 4 takes tuition class and in the afternoon elder used to take tuition especially for math and science.

Ritan won 1st prize in pot breaking game, karan won 1st position in chocolate game and Dewika won 1st prize in balloon breaking game. Prizes were distributed among them.

Anoj is attending his regular extra classes in the evening time. Toyaz is admitted to class 11 at management stream. He is regularly attending his classes and spends his much time in study rather than playing and waling arounds with his friends, he is seen to be serious then before.

Hygiene

Due to increasing dengue infection, the children's home premises were cleaned of garbage, wild leaves were cut down and waterlogging areas were filled with mud.

The office manager sprayed mosquito repellent inside and outside the home premises to kill and destroy dengue mosquitoes and prevent new ones from breeding.
