Beste donateur/belangstellende

Hierbij onze nieuwsbrief waarin wordt samengevat wat de belangrijkste resultaten zijn van dit jaar en een overzicht van wat het komende jaar nodig is voor het kinderreus.

We zijn ons als bestuur bewust van de noodzaak van een meer professionele inzet van personeel om de kinderen de juiste begeleiding te kunnen geven.

Duhabi Children Home is stevig geworteld in de lokale samenleving en weet zich o.a gesteund door de gemeente, vertegenwoordigd in de adviesraad.

Teneinde manager Ash Kumar meer vaardigheden bij te brengen is hij begonnen met de part-time opleiding Social Work (BSW) en wordt begeleid door een door ons benoemde Supervisory Committee. Het kinderreus krijgt nog de tijd om aan alle voorwaarden van de overheid te voldoen waaronder dat jongeren vanaf 18j niet meer in een kindertehuis mogen wonen. Ook moet zoveel mogelijk worden uitgesloten dat kinderen in het kinderreus wonen die nog bij familie kunnen verblijven. Hiervoor is gedegen onderzoek nodig om familieleden op te sporen.

We willen nog steeds voorkomen dat jongeren na hun 18e in het buitenland (Qatar, Saoedi Arabie etc.) moeten aan werken of daar zelf voor kiezen ondanks alle gevaren. Simpelweg omdat er geen werk is in Nepal.

Hoewel er nog veel kan worden verbeterd heeft het kinderreus de coronapandemie goed doorstaan en zijn de kinderen hierin liefdevol opgevangen en begeleid.

Alle kinderen zijn gevaccineerd, hebben boosters gehad. Een meisje (Anju) heeft TBC opgelopen en is inmiddels hersteld.

Zonder Uw financiële bijdrage is het onmogelijk om de kinderen perspectief te bieden.

Wij hopen daarom opnieuw op Uw steun in 2023.

The project-An Overview

Duhabi Children Home has been operating since 2004 A.D. with the support of SSCHD (Stichting Shide Children Home Netherlands) in Nepal. For the past 19 years, Stichting has been



major donor organization. A small portion of the cash and in-kind budget comes from local donors, clubs and municipalities. The primary goal of the project is to address the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual needs of orphan and helpless children. We provide love, care, food, advice, guidance, and the highest standard of education to them so they can become valued members of society with a bright future. Because of the death of the parents, the re-marriage of abandoned / widowed / divorced women, children are left

without care and support. We look after those children in the Duhabi Children Home.

Currently, Duhabi Children Home have 24 children and is expecting five more orphan children in 2023. The home caters for all basic needs to grow up in an affectionate, caring and safe environment. To support the children there are 2-caregivers, 1 cook, 2-part time tutors, 1 dance teacher, 1 computer teacher and project manager. However, the home still needs a guard/handy man to join us.

Partner Organization

Duhabi Children Home (DCH) is in operation since 2004 A.D. with the support of the SSCHD (Stichting Shide Children Home Netherlands) in Nepal. In the last 19 years Stichting has been the main donor of this organization. A small part of our budget in cash and kinds are provided by local donors, clubs and municipality.

Mission

The primary mission of the project is to provide orphaned, needy, helpless children, with a home, love, happiness, physical, mental, emotional and spiritual nourishment, the highest possible level of education.

Objectives:

1. To provide a safe, Caring and loving environment for orphaned children aged 3 to 18, who are vulnerable, Orphaned or abandoned.
2. Where possibly relate with remaining relatives and eventually unite with them.
3. To provide various opportunities creating the environment where orphan children can safely build up a social network, play, have hobbies and study.
4. To protect rights of orphaned.
5. All who are staff/ board members have signed a code of conduct.

Goal

The project also aims to provide orphan and homeless children of eastern part of Nepal with the highest possible level of education and guidance, so they can grow to be valuable members of the community and nation.

Office Manager

Mr. Aashu Kumar Mandal (Ash Kumar) lives close to Duhabi home, he is young, energetic, hardworking, devoted to Social Work and motivated. He is passionate about kids and the foundation. He is responsible for the office management and

the necessary fieldwork tasks. He is a member of the local Lion's club and coordinates local donations for the Children home. OM is also taking BSW Course i.e. Bachelor in Social work.

Home mother & Kitchen Mother



Muna Khatiwada and Harimaya Timshina are resident mothers of the foundation, they look after the children at day and night. Muna is a home mother and Harimaya works as a cooking mother for 10 years, they became highly experienced! they are satisfied with their works and they know all the children personally at home. They will however retire after a few months and we're in the process of finding replacement, qualified for looking after the children.

Assistant Mother

Prinkaya Singh (23) is working as an Assistant mother at DCH. She can cook, look after the children and do a good job at home. She is SLC (Highschool) graduate with good sense of humor and help the (younger) children at night to read and write before going to bed.

Part time tutors

For the development in Children's education two different teachers have been appointed to the foundation.



Miss Isha Kumari hails from the neighboring community. She is highly motivated in the education of children, particularly mathematics and science. Isha has special talent, explaining kids of various ages! She is hired to look after the older children she used to come in the evening. Where miss Asha Shah is a primary level teacher who is good at handling younger children and comes in the morning, she is specially hired for younger children.



Duhabi Board and Supervisory Committee

There is a committee (council) which is the executive body of the home, to run home very well. There are 11 members and the council is to observe the care for the children, to supervise the work performed by the staff members and to inspect the children's home in addition, manage the home. Also there is an independent supervisory committee of 3 members responsible for the monitoring of the funds granted by Stichting and bringing back the results to the Stichting.

Examples of Children after growing up in the home

Dipesh

Dipesh was 4 years raised in the house Duhabi Children home. After losing both of his parents, Dipesh was admitted to a Children's home. There he became an inspiring youth. He graduated from Manmohan technical University in Nepal and completed an internship with a technical company in Biratnagar and currently working as supervisor at Hetauda where he and his family live happily after that.

Bimal

BIMAL was introduced to Stichting by Mr. Parajuli, a teacher from Khanar village. He lost his leg in a fire when living with his uncle. He was transferred to Duhabi home in 2004 A.D. With help of the Stichting Bimal was sent to Pokhara Green Pastoral hospital for a re-amputation of his leg and providing a leg prosthesis. He was only six years old when Duhabi Children Home (DCH) intervened to assist him through this long-term care program. Throughout the years supported by home mother, after completing his SLC (high school), he worked in a factory, was trained as a cook, got married, just recently he opened his own guesthouse in Duhabi supported by his wife.

Riju

Like many of the children at Duhabi home, Riju was only a small child when he came to the orphanage home. He was just 3 years old when Duhabi home decided to take him under its wings, give him a new home, a new family and hope for better future. Having grown up at the Children's home, Riju showed much promise and excelled in several areas, including painting and wall arts. After completing his 12th grade, Riju was trained by a professional artist to develop his painting skills. During that training he had the opportunity to become barista in a company belonging to the Rock start network and is currently employed in Coffee shop at Kathmandu. He mastered in coffee making and cash management and bill counter at the Restaurant.



Extra-curricular Achievements

Three Children from Duhabi Children home won 1st and 2nd prizes in games competition which was organized by child care union. CCU is an organization of orphanages located in Province No. 1, which supervises and monitor the orphanage. There are 15 orphanages under it including DCH.

Surya won the man of the match award in the football tournament organized by the school. Toyaz was selected for SEE Soccer match where he won man of the match medal.

Toyaz was selected and played Soccer/ Football game which was organized by Duhabi Municipality named as 4th Mayor Cup. He was represented as player of Ward Number 5. On the first game they won against ward number 9 and qualified for next match.



- Every child has opportunity for indoor and out-door recreation and play facilities along with training in crafts and hobbies.
- After passing Class 10 Children's i.e. SEE examination the children are provided with vocational training through this organization.

Achievements

About wall restauration

The restauration of the collapsed brick wall is completed and a zinc plate has been placed to prevent future collapse. The cost for materials and construction were much higher than originally estimated, Thanks to local contributions and supports of Stichting Shide children home Netherlands.

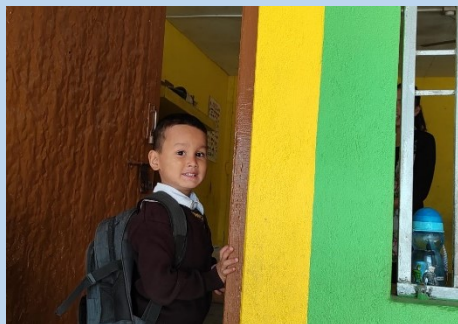
DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1.	Recommendation letter of Municipality and ward.
2.	Death certificate of father or mother.
3.	Application from Child's relative.
4.	Citizenship card photocopy of Applicants.
5.	Birth registration certificate of children.
6.	Citizenship card photocopy of Parents.
7.	Field visit report.
8.	Current situation photo of Children.
9.	Medical report.
10.	Citizenship photocopy of two persons known to the families of the children of the concerned place.

*That family relations be maintained for the children of our home who still have parents but are unable to care for them.

New Children at home

Amrit and Amrita's father passed away when they were very young and their mother married to someone else. They were born in the district Kavre, after the children were housed together with their uncle and aunt in Duhabi who were also suffering from financial crisis. Their uncle and aunt were a hard time raising these two children and therefore desperately needed our support. Their uncle and aunt were unable to meet the needs of the children and were not taking care of them.



Balen came to live at the Children's home on march 10, he was only three when he was admitted at DH. His mother passed away due to Covid-19 and father remarried and settled in India. He was staying with his old grandmother who was having trouble looking after the young boy. They resided in a temporary house built on government land. His grandmother was not able to provide him with food and remained begging and requesting food in the vicinity. The ward chairman was informed of the whaling situation

and after necessary investigation and permission from her grandmother, for more care and assistance he was transferred to Duhabi Home. He started attending a school close to DH. They need support of SSCHN, to become a good child in society.

Child Club and activities of Child Club

This year Child Club of Duhabi Children Home organized 5 different fun games namely pot breaking, Music mania, Chocolate eating, Race, balloon blasting. The main attraction of the program was a talent show. There were 3 item which includes group dance, acting/drama, art display and speech reading. Prizes were distributed among the winners and lastly weekly cleanliness and sanitation program were also conducted by them. The Supervisory committee meets with the child club on regular basis to get their suggestions for improvement.

Annual plan for 2023

Through the joint effort of the members, the board of directors, supervisory committee and the manager, the annual budget and plan were prepared. We have outlined our 2023 annual plan. We are looking for (local) donors to support children and run the organization.

- Painting the whole building from outside.
- Plastering of cracks and holes in wall and renovation of ladders.
- Construction of study room at terrace.
- Installation of CCTV Camera.
- Furnishing the study room.

In 2023 Duhabi Children's Home can accommodate 5 more orphaned or helpless children.

Achievements of Duhabi Home in 2022

Duhabi Home has following objectives in the year 2023:

- Successfully raised local donation at 35% of total expenditure in cash and kinds. (Rice, oil, lentils, clothes etc.)
- Successfully constructed the wall.
- With the help of municipality DH have constructed 16 new beds for children.

COVID-19 AND VACCINATION



Covid-19 was an unprecedented pandemic that hit Nepal in the mid-week of April. 2021 The Country never saw such a predicament in its history, thus making it an extreme challenge for the government to counter the problem with necessary measures. While the Children are unable to leave the orphanage to go to school, they have been making the most of their together within the permitted areas. The Children were kept healthy and active, there have also been outdoor sessions, including exercise and games. Creativity is being explored, and some of our children have kept themselves busy in drawing and playing indoor games. Children were vaccinated by 2nd and booster dose of Pfizer immunization at their school on dated 1st week of July.



Regular Health Check-Up

Dr. from Health post did a health camp at Children home. Altogether 23 Children and staff members benefited from the camp. The Medical team has conducted a day camp in the orphanage. It was done to ensure health of children. The main aims of the health camps were to check the general health of the children, to monitor the oral hygiene of the children, the aim is to educate the children on hygiene and sanitation.



Entertainment



For the entertainment and refreshment for children they are provided with dance classes twice a week. Miss Simran is a good dance teacher with a local reputation, she's been teaching dance our children long enough.

Reshmi



DUHABI CHILDREN HOME (DCH) has been providing services and care on behalf of Stichting to one of the Children who is residing at Dharan. Reshmi is 18 years old girl, she lives with her mother and grandmother, in a hut. Her father left when she was approx. 2. She doesn't have any other paternal or maternal relatives. She is studying in class 11 with management subject. She is good in her study. She needs extra care and support to build up her future. She is only able to have a bright future in community through the generous support of a Dutch sponsor.

SAFETY

The home doesn't have surveillance system and manpower. We should be aware of intruder at night and aware of unwanted people during day time too. It is also helpful to monitor the children's activities

Beyond Education

There is a youth program, a project for dependent children of DH after the age 18. Meanwhile, they receive skills basic training and provide them with vocational training, they need to live on their own after high school graduation. Find a career and become active members of society. Board member of DH helps them to provide citizenship card, find a job and secure place to live, besides that the foundation looks for 3 years after that.

Needs

Constructing Study room at terrace

For the maximum capacity of 25 Children and staff members 3 bedrooms are not enough. For the number of boys another room is urgently required, so we have to build the study room to the terrace and convert the study room to a boy's room. Looking at the other side, there is the fear of unwanted incidents to keep them at same room. As well there are a lot of small repair and maintenance of work in DH. The stairs need to be plastered because there are some cracks in stairs, the walls should need to be plastered, the ground floor also need to be repair, the coloring of the home is not done by 15 years so there should be coloring the outside of building.



For the construction of new room at terrace needs approx. 6,00,000 Nrs, € 4560.
For the coloring of building from outside needs 90,000Nrs, € 685.
